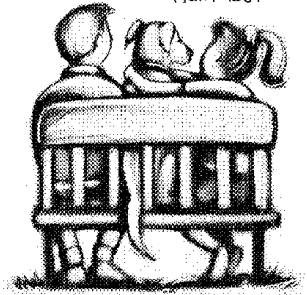

**Mothers Prayer Group.**

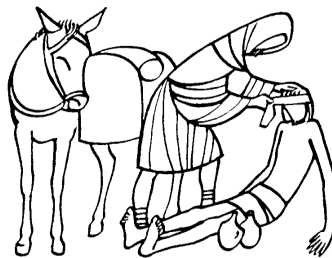
