Diocesan Pilgrimage to Harvington Hall, the Shrine of the English Martyrs Sunday 2nd September Harvington Hall is a beautiful moated manor house with the largest surviving series of priest hides in the country. Originally built in the 1300s and developed magnificently in the late 1500s, Harvington Hall brings to life the fascinating history of the survival of Roman Catholic families and clergymen during the Reformation of the late sixteenth century. Visitors will discover the Hall's many ingenious secret priest hides, many of which were designed by St. Nicholas Owen, Mass will be celebrated at 3pm. The Principal Celebrant: Rt Rev Robert Byrne CO, Auxiliary Bishop of Birmingham. Preacher: Canon David Oakley Rector of Oscott College. Hopefully there will be a Deanery Coach travelling that day. People will need to take their own chair for Mass.
