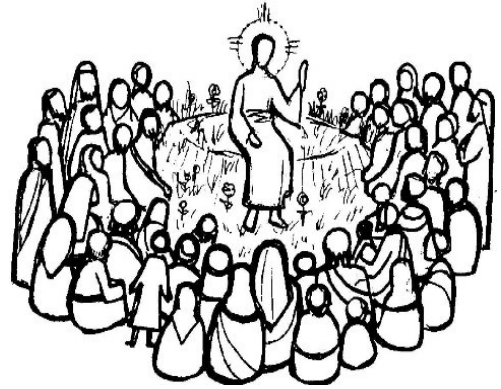

YEAR 11 CELEBRATING RECORD GCSE RESULTS IN 2018 AT CARDINAL NEWMAN SCHOOL

Students and staff at Cardinal Newman Catholic School are celebrating record GCSE examination results this year with students achieving the best results in the school's history. A fantastic 85% of students achieved a grade 4 pass or better in English, 75% in Mathematics and 81% in RE. 71% of students achieved a standard pass or better in both GCSE English and Mathematics. With the introduction of new GCSE courses in most subjects this year, it has been a very challenging year for Year 11 students. Students have worked incredibly hard and their excellent results are a tribute to their commitment and perseverance as well as the hard work and dedication of all the staff.
