HOLY WEEK

Today on Palm Sunday we have entered into Holy week. This is the week that defines our faith. Jesus enters Jerusalem to cries of "Hosanna" and a few days later is crucified on a cross. We celebrate this week with devotion recalling the events that are the very heart of our faith. Maundy Thursday we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7 00pm followed by watching until 9 pm. Extraordinary ministers will be re commissioned on this night. The altar is stripped. On Good Friday we come together at 3 00pm to hear the reading of the Passion from John's gospel and then we venerate the cross and receive Holy Communion. Good Friday is the only day that Mass is not celebrated. On Saturday the Mass starts later than a usual Saturday Mass at 7 30 pm Here we celebrate the fight back of light against the darkness of sin and the victory of Jesus over death that grants us the hope we have for heaven. On Easter Sunday our joyful Mass is at 10 am.

On Tuesday at 7 00pm at Christ the King there is a Penance Service and many priests will be there to hear confessions. Confessions at Holy Family Monday evening 6 00pm until 7 00pm and Tuesday after Mass until 10 30 am

There are envelopes for the collection at both Easter Masses which are the traditional offering for the fattening of your parish priest!

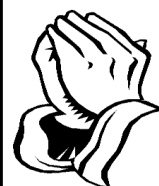
