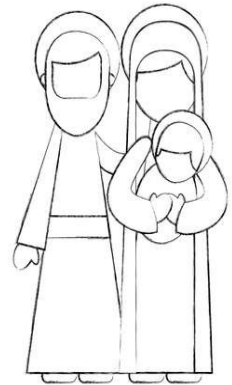

## Hospital Pastoral Care

Fr Paul, the full time Catholic priest chaplain to the hospital has been appointed to All Souls, as Parish Priest. It looks like the diocese will not be replacing him at the hospital, and the responsibility for the pastoral care will have to be shared by the deanery priests. (not all of them will offer cover) At present the deanery were covering days off and holidays, but now it will mean every day needing to be covered. ***If you are going into hospital please let me know, and because of data protection you will have to let me know which ward also. I will visit you at hospital if you let me know when you will be in.*** I will be still covering 24 hour periods, which do involve night calls, the difference will be those days will increase. It is sad that there will not be a Catholic priest present, and working full time in the hospital, there is a vital ministry there that takes time to build up and flourish. Fr Paul has been an excellent chaplain at the hospital and he will be missed.
