

<u>HOLY FAMILY PARISH CENTRE</u> NATIONAL LOTTERY GRANT

In 2018 the Parish buildings were inspected by the Diocese. The report that followed highlighted several areas that needed to be addressed and rectified. One of the most urgent areas was the installation of a toilet for the less abled in the Parish Centre; without which the Centre could not be used for public use and hire.

In May this year we applied to the National Lottery for funding. This application was successful and during August this year, work began to install the toilet for the less abled. All works have been carried out by approved builders H Sykes and Sons.
